



PROVIDING NV TO A STUNNING NEW CHRISTCHURCH LANDMARK

The ANZ Centre sits on the former Triangle Centre site in the heart of Christchurch's CBD. A stunning example of modern architecture, this 3-storey building, comprises a mix of retail and office space and features a striking atrium in which people can eat, drink and relax.

The building's main façades are made from lightly tinted, high performance glass, with good visible light transmittance and with expressed vertical mullions. Spandrel panels and vision glazing are complementary and horizontal joints are minimized to present a vertical proportion.

Ellisco's role:

Thermosash, the façade designer, asked us to specify suitable actuators for windows in the atrium area, which needed to open electronically.

We assisted Leigh Construction and the electricians with wiring layouts and control equipment locations, and supplied and installed Windowmaster motor controllers and actuators to windows located high in the atrium to provide natural ventilation. We then tested these.

The outcome:

We provided the controllers and actuators on time and within budget and they are working well.
